Brazil Coffee Weather stly Dry After A few Showers Today

Kansas City, June 23 (World Weather, Inc.) – A few shower and thunderstorms
npacted northern Sao Paulo, southern Sul de Minas and in a few areas from Espirito San
to central Minas Gerais Wedensday. A few showers will linger in these areas today and
then mostly dry weather will dominate coffee areas through the balance of the next ten days. Temperatures will be mild to warm throughout the forecast period.

BRAZIL

Stattered showers and a few thunderstorms occurred Wednesday in northeastern Sao Paulo and far southernmost Sul de Minas. Rainfall at official reporting sites varied up to 11 millimeters, but satellite imagery sugested locally greater amounts may have occurred in a few areas. Spotty showers of limited significance also occurred from Espirito Santo into central Minas Gerais, but none of that rain was considered significant.

High temperatures Wednesday afternoon were in the upper teens and lower 20s Celsius from northern Parana through southern and eastern Sao Paulo to eastern Minas Gerais and Espirito Santo. Highs in most other areas were in the middle 20s to near 30 degrees with extremes of 31 in northern Minas Gerais.

Showers will end today in southern Minas Gerais and Rio de Janeiro. After that mostly dry conditions will dominate coffee areas through the balance of the next ent days. Rainfall today will be no more than 7 millimeters. A few coastal areas in Bahia and Espirito Santo will receive rain periodically in the next ten days, but most of the precipitation will sand will receive rain periodically in the next ten days, but most of the precipitation will stay outside of coffee production areas.

Temperatures will be seasonable over the next week to ten days. Daily highs will be in the 20s Celsius except from northern Minas Gerais to Bahia where upper 20s and lower 30s are most likely. There will be a few upper teen afternoon temperatures in the southeast periodically. Lowest morning temperatures will remain mostly in the upper single digits and teens. A few lower 20-degree lows will occur in the far north and along the upper Atlantic Coast periodically.
