1 MINUTE IN THE COFFEE

Brazil Coffee Weather
Quite Chilly Friday Morning

By Drew Lerner - Kansas City, July 20 (World Weather, Inc.) - Temperatures continued to contrast across Brazil's crop country Tuesday with very warm temperatures occurring in northern Minas Gerais and Bahia while temperatures in the south were seasonably cool. The same bias will prevail through the weekend with the next coldest morning expected Friday. Some patchy soft frost will be possible once again in the traditionally coldest areas in southern Sul de Minas and a few other locations, but the impact on most trees is not likely to be very great.

BRAZIL

Up to 5 millimeters of rain fell along the Bahia coast Tuesday while all coffee production areas were dry. High temperatures were in the upper teens and 20s Celsius in many areas. The warmest weather continued from northern and western Minas Gerais into central Bahia where highs were in the upper 20s through the lower 30s. An extreme high of 36 occurred in central Bahia. Rain will continue restricted in Brazil coffee country during the next seven to ten days. Most of the precipitation that evolves will be near the coast from eastern Minas Gerais and Espírito Santo to eastern Bahia. Coastal areas will receive all of the significant rain and any moisture that reaches into coffee and cocoa production areas will have a minor impact on trees and future production potentials.

Another bout of cool weather is expected Thursday and Friday. The situation is not likely to be much different from that of Monday morning when pockets of very light frost occurred in some low-lying areas of Sul de Minas. The impact of Monday's frost was minimal and the same was expected on Friday which is likely to be the coolest morning. Most low temperatures at the end of this week will slip to between 4 and 9 degrees from northern Parana to southern Sul de Minas. A few spots in southern most Sul de Minas might again slip down to between 1 and 3 degrees with some pockets of soft frost possible, but the impact will be very low. Low temperatures further north will be 6 to 11 degrees during the cooler days which will likely be Thursday and Friday in the south and Saturday and Sunday in the north. Northern Minas Gerais and Bahia will not cool off more than the range of 10 to 15 degrees and some locations will still be warmer.

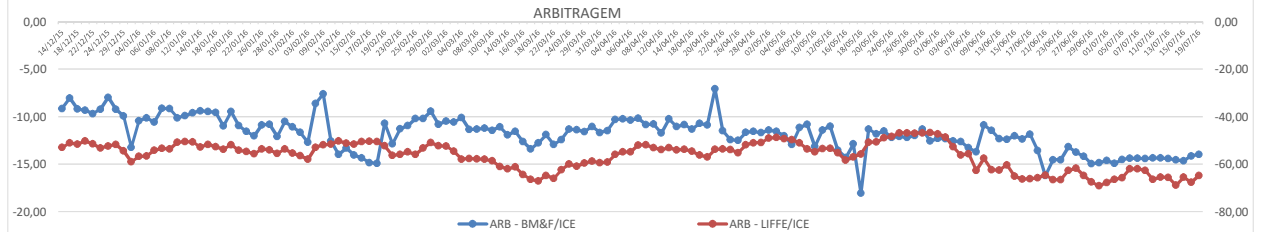
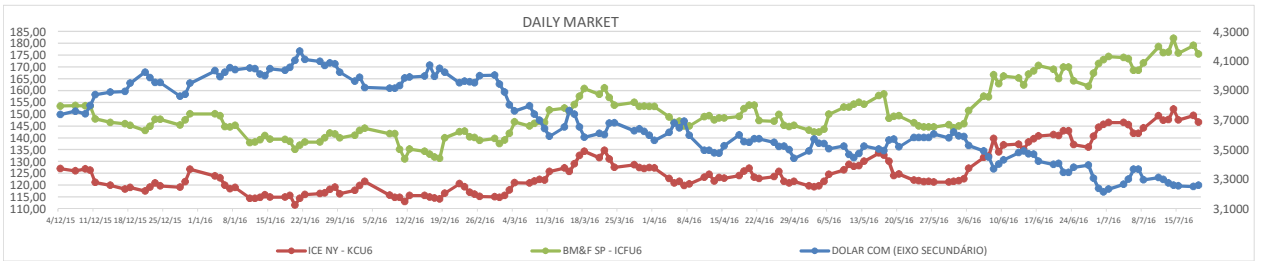
Afternoon high temperatures will be in the upper teens and lower to a few middle 20s during the cooler days late this week. Otherwise, highs will be in the 20s south and upper 20s to lower 30s most often in the north. A few extremes of 35-36 will continue possible in the driest areas of Bahia and northern Minas Gerais.
