## 1 MINUTE IN THE COFFEE

Kansas City, July 22 (World Weather, Inc.) – Temperatures were nippy in southern Sul de Minas this morning with a few of the coldest locations possibly experiencing some frost and freeze conditions. However, the incident of frost was suspected of being less than that of Monday and the area impacted was so small that production will not be impacted. Mild to cool conditions will prevail this weekend, but conditions will be warmer over the following week to ten days. Rainfall will be limited to coastal Bahia, extreme eastern Minas Gerais and Espirito Santo.

## BRAZII

A small pool of cold air settled over southern Sul de Minas this morning and like early this week there may have been a little frost in the colder locations. However, the vast majority of coffee areas from northern Parana through all of Minas Gerais and Rio de Janeiro had pre-dawn temperatures in the upper single digits through the lower teens Celsius. In the colder pocket, however, west pre-dawn temperatures were in the range of 0.6 to 4.0 Celsius as shown above. These are the same locations that tend to be coldest in the region and any frost that occurred this morning would likely have been less significant than that of Monday. Minimal damage was suspected and the area is so small relative to all of coffee country, that its impact should have been negligible.

High temperatures Thursday afternoon were mostly in the upper teens and 20s Celsius from northern Parana and southern and eastern Sao Paulo to southeastern Minas Gerais, Rio de Janeiro and southern Espirito Santo, including Zona de Mata. Highs elsewhere were in the upper 20s and lower 30s with extremes of 34 in northern Minas Gerais and 35 in central Bahia. The only rain reported Thursday was along the middle Espirito Santo coast and amounts were only 3 millimeters. Cool weather will abate from southern coffee areas of Brazil this weekend and a mild to warm bias in temperatures will then prevail for the following ten days. Lowest morning temperatures during the period will be in the upper single digits through the teens most often followed by high temperatures mostly in the 20s south and in the upper 20s to lower 30s north. Extreme highs will continue to get up around 35 in central Bahia and a few northern Minas Gerais locations. A couple of extreme lows of 4 to 7 will be possible Saturday and Sunday in the same areas erporting today's lowest temperatures. Rain will continue restricted in Brazil coffee country during the next seven to ten days. Most of the precipitation that evokes will be in eastern Minas Gerais and near the coast of Espirito Santo to eastern Bahia. Coastal areas will receive and future production potentials.
