Brazil Coffee Weather
Dry, Mild to Warm For At Least Another Ten Days

Kansas City, August 2 (World Weather, Inc.) – No significant rain fell in Brazil coffee production areas Monday and similar conditions were expected through the middle part of next week. Temperatures were mild to warm and there will be no risk of crop damaging cold for at least another week to ten days.



Dry weather occurred in most of Brazil's coffee production region Monday. A few showers occurred in coastal Bahia with rain amounts to 3 millimeters. Most interior coffee areas were dry. High temperatures Monday afternoon were mostly in the 20s with extreme highs of 30 to 32 in far northern Sao Paulo and in central Bahia. No serious change to the ten day outlook for Brazil's coffee areas occurred overnight, atthough a few more showers may pop up in protinos of Parana and Sao Paulo during the second half of next week. Until then, very little rain of significance is expected and temperatures will be mild to warm throughout the production region. There will be no threats of frost or freeze conditions. Daily high temperatures through August 12 will be in the 20s Celsius most often with a few upper teens in southeastern most portions of the production region, especially Rio de Janeiro to eastern Sao Paulo. In contrast, a few daily extreme highs of 30 to 34 will occur from northern Minas Gerais to central Bahia.

Rain will fall periodically along the coast of Espirito Santo and Bahia through the forecast period. Only a few of the showers will evolve far enough inland to reach coffee areas and when that happens, resulting rainfall will be minimal.

Some of the computer forecast models are suggesting some cooling during the week August 14, but the significance of that change is unclear at this time.
