1 MINUTE IN THE COFFEE - Chilly Temperatures This Morning In Southern Sul de Minas - By Drew Lerner
Kansas City, August 12 (World Weather, Inc.) - Cooler air continued to press further to the north in coffee areas of southern
Brazil Thursday and early today. A few of the traditionally coldest locations near the southernmost border of Sul de Minas with
Sao Paulo dropped down slightly below freezing. These coldest temperatures were near coffee production areas, although
were isolated incients and not representative of the majority of coffee country in which temperatures stayed well above the
frost threshold. Saturday morning temperatures will be similar to those of today with the majority of coffee areas not
threatened by the cool conditions. Cooler air will reach into northern coffee country, however, and that will bring down the very
warm to hot temperatures of recent days in northern Minas Gerais and Bahia.

BRAZIL

Near dawn temperatures this morning were mostly in the middle and upper single digits Celsius – well above the frost
threshold. However, a few of the traditionally coldest
locations near coffee areas of far southern Sul de Minas did slip into the frost and light freeze range. These locations, however,
do not represent the majority of coffee country and most of the nation's coffee was not threatened with damaging conditions.
The locations reporting freezes this morning have consistently reported the coolest conditions near coffee country throughout
the winter season this year.

Most other low temperatures to the northern of Sul de Minas had lows in the upper single digits and teers this morning while
areas to the west and south across Sao Paulo and northern Parana were mostly in the middle and upper single digits like that
of most of Sul de Minas.

No rain fell across Brazil coffee areas Thursday and afternoon temperatures were mild in the south and warm to hot in the

No rain fell across Brazil coffee areas Thursday and afternoon temperatures were mild in the south and warm to hot in the north. Afternoon highs were mostly in the upper teens in eastern and southern Sao Paulo northward into far southern Sul de Minas while lower 20s occurred elsewhere from northern Parana to the remainder of southern Sul de Minas and Rio de Janeiro. In contrast, highs from northern Minas Gerals to central Bahia were in the range of 30 to 37 with readings over 35 in northern Minas Gerals to central Bahia.

Cooler air will spread a little further to the north today and Saturday with the hottest readings in central Bahia falling back to the

Cooler air will spread a little further to the north today and Saturday with the hottest readings in central Bahia falling back to the lower 30s while upper 20s to near 30 occur in northern Miras Gerais and readings in the 20s occur in central and southern Miras Gerais. Highs in the upper teens and lower 20s will occur from eastern Sao Paulo into far southern Sul de Minas and southern Rio de Janeiro. Saturday morning lows will slip into the lower and middle single digits from northeastern Sao Paulo through southern Sul de Minas to parts of interior higher elevated areas of Rio de Janeiro. Some frost and a couple of light freezes may occur in a few locations just like today, but the impact will be no different. Most lows Saturday will in the remainder of the nation will be in the upper single digits and teens.

Warming is expected Saturday afternoon through the first half of next week with daily highs reaching the range of middle 20s to lower 30s in much of coffee country followed by lows in the upper single digits through the teens.

A few sporadic showers will occur today through the weekend in a few Minas Gerais and Espirito Santo locations, but most of the region is not expected to receive significant rain. A few of the greatest showers will produce up to 5 millimeters of rain. A better chance for rain will develop in Parana and Sao Paulo Monday and will shift northward into the heart of Minas Gerais Tuesday before dissipating Wednesday. Rainfall of a trace to 6 millimeters will occur most often with a local total to 10 millimeters.

Another frontal system will bring a chance for additional showers to Parana and Sao Paulo late next week and into the following weekend. Rain totals will vary from 1 to 8 millimeters with a few totals to 15 millimeters each day. The precipitation

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
