Kansas City, August 23 (World Weather, Inc.) – Cooler air remained over southern Brazil coffee production areas this morning, but no crop threatening cold conditions were noted. The region is expected to remain mild the remainder of this week and into the weekend while precipitation is limited to a few coastal areas.

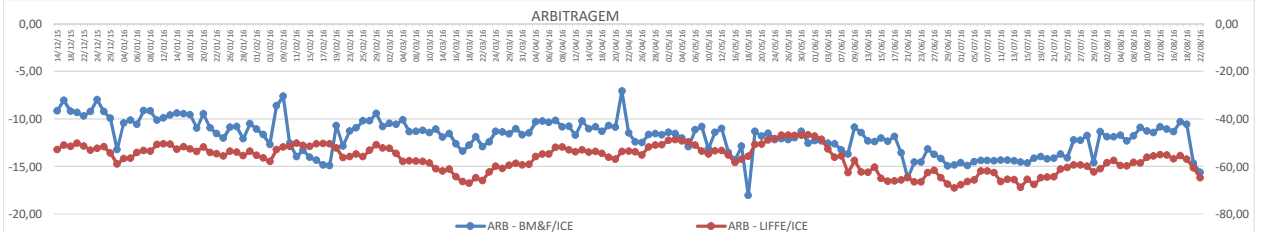
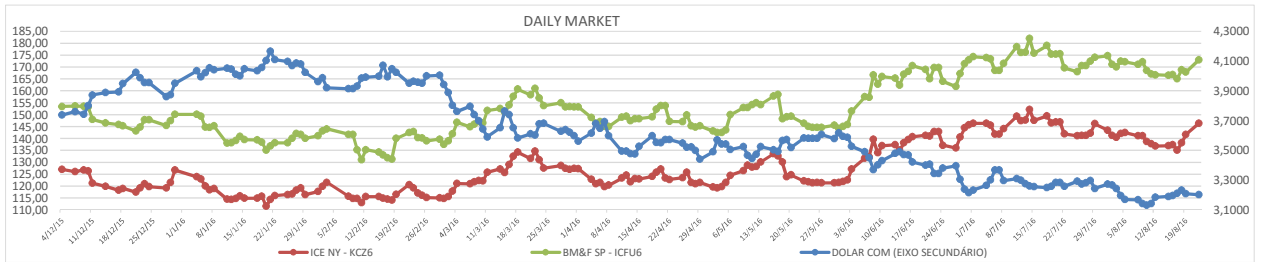
BRAZIL

Rain Monday was confined to a few coastal areas where up to 5 millimeters resulted. Temperatures contrasted sharply across the production region with highs in the teens in eastern Sao Paulo, portions of Rio de Janeiro and extreme southern Sul de Minas. The port city of Sao Paulo only reached 13 degrees Celsius for an afternoon high. Temperatures elsewhere in southern Brazil coffee areas from Zona de Mata and Sul de Minas into northern Parana were in the lower 20s. In contrast, highs in central Bahia reached 37 and most areas from central through northern Minas Gerais and in eastern Bahia reported afternoon temperatures in the upper 20s through the lower 30s.

Temperatures this morning were non-threatening except in the higher elevated areas of far southern Sul de Minas near the Sao Paulo and Rio de Janeiro borders where some frost and light freezes occurred, but these temperatures were not representative of most coffee areas which were nowhere near cold enough to raise a threat to crops. Dry weather will occur in most of Brazil's coffee country through the next week. Some rain will be possible in Parana and Sao Paulo a week from today and it will shift

further north while dissipating in the Aug. 31-Sep 1 period. Rainfall should be light at that time leaving any crops that flowered this week because of rain still in need of significant moisture to support pollination.

Temperatures will remain mild to cool for the next few days, but there will be no risk of crop damaging cold. Daily highs through Friday will be in the upper teens and lower 20s from Parana to Sul de Minas and in the 20s in most other areas. Several extreme highs of 30 to 34 will occur from northern Minas Gerais into central Bahia. Lowest temperatures at night through the end of this week will be in the range of 7 to 13 south and in the teens and lower 20s north. Temperatures during the weekend and next week will be in the 20s south and middle 20s to middle 30s north followed by lows in the upper single digits and teens. A few extreme lows as warm as the lower 20s will continue in the far north.
