1 Minute in the coffee - Rain To Shift Northward Into Bahia Today - By Drew Lerner
Kansas City, September 26 (World Weather, Inc.) - Rain developed from Cerrado Minerio into Zona de Mata and parts of Rio
de Janeiro during the weekend with coastal showers in Bahia. Most of the precipitation will shift and concentrate on northern
coffee areas from Espirito Santo and central and eastern Minas Gerais into Bahia early this week. The second half of this
week will be dry and warmer.

Satellite imagery and surface weather observations suggested scattered showers and thunderstorms developed during the weekend from Cerrado Mineiro north and east to central Bahia, Zona de Mata and a few locations in eastern and southern SU de Minas. Satellite imagery also suggested a few showers in eastern and southern Suo Paulo, but mostly outside of coffee country. Reported rainfall through 0600 GMT today ranged from 1 to 22 millimeters which was probably not enough to induce flowering in most areas, but a few pockets of flowering cannot be ruled out.

Highest temperatures Friday through Sunday were in the upper 20s and lower 30s in many areas, but middle 30s were noted in northern Sao Paulo and from northern Minas Gerais to central Bahia. Lowest morning temperatures were in the teens and lower 20s.

Rain will continue from Zona de Mata and Espirito Santo northward to all of Bahia today and Tuesday with most of the precipitation diminishing Wednesday. During the three day period rain totals will vary from 10 to 40 millimeters with a few greater totals to more

than 50 millimeters. The precipitation might bring on some flowering and for Bahia, northern Minas Gerais and Espirito Santo. Flowering does not usually occur this early in the season. A close monitoring of rainfall during October will be necessary to make sure any premature flowering gets successfully. The trees are too weak to flower as profused to be widespread and some forecasters have already suggested the multi-year drought has left trees in poor condition and they may not yield well this year even if flowering and polination occur successfully. The trees are too weak to flower as profused.

The La Nina like conditions that are prevailing this spring should be supportive of follow up rain later in October reducing some of the concern over premature flowering, but the situation will need to be closely monitored.

Once rain ends Wednesday, precipitation that occurs during the balance of this workweek is unlikely

veakening during the first half of next week. Rainfall of 5 to 15 millimeters will be most likely with a few totals to 25 millimeters One more surge of greater rain may evolve from Parana to Zona de Mata and Cerrado Mineiro late next week with better rain

intensity and coverage possible.

Temperatures early this week may be a little cooler biased in the rainfall areas of the north. Most highs in Brazil coffee areas

Temperatures early this week may be a tittle cooler based in the raintal areas of the north. Most ingins in traiza cortee areas through Wednesday will be in the upper 20s through the lower 30s with numerous middle 30-degrees highs in the north. Low temperatures early this week will rarely be cooler than 10 and most readings will be in the range of 12 to 19 with a few 20-22 degree readings in the far north.

The warmest weather is expected late this week and into the weekend with highs in the upper 20s through the 30s in most coffee areas followed by lows in the teens and lower 20s. Another bout of cooler weather will come with rain that evolves late in the weekend and early next week.


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
