Returning Rainfall Parana To Zona de Mata Next Week - By Drew Lerner

Kansas City, September 29 (World Weather, Inc.) – Not much rain fell in coffee areas Wednesday and similar conditions were expected through Saturday. A boost in rainfall is expected Sunday and Monday from Parana to Rio de Janeiro and Zona de Mata followed by frequent showers and thunderstorms from Sui de Minas into southern Bahia Tuesday through Friday, Oct. 4-7. Temperatures will be seasonably warm until next week.

BRAZIL

BHA/LIL
Dry and warm weather occurred in most Brazil coffee production areas Wednesday. A few showers occurred near the Bahia
coast where rainfall through 0600 GMT today reached 4 millimeters. All other areas were unaffected by rain and high
temperatures were mostly in the upper 20s to lower 30s. A few extreme highs of 35-36 occurred in northern Sao Paulo and
northern Minas Gerais while a few readings in the lower 20s occurred near southern Zora de Mata.

Not much precipitation will occur today through Saturday, although totally dry weather is not very likely. Rainfall will vary from a few millimeters up to 8 millimeters with most of that expected from northern and eastern parts of Sul de Minas and a part of Zona de Mata into eastern Bathia and coastal Espirito Santo. Coverage of rain will be poor and temperatures will be warm enough to maintain a strong rate of evaporation so that most crop areas experience net drying conditions. Rain will evolve from Parana to Sul de Minas and Rio de Janeiro Sunday and Monday before expanding and prevailing during the middle to latter part of next week. Daily rainfall of 5 to 20 millimeters will be most likely with a few totals of 20 to 50 millimeters. The greatest rain will be from southern and eastermost Sao Paulo to Rio de Janeiro and a few neighboring areas of southern Sul de Minas. Some arain may also evolve in Zona de Mata early next week with rainfall of 5 to 20 millimeters. Next week's rain (Tuesday through Friday) will occur from interior portions of Sul de Minas to southern Bahia and some amounts may be sufficient to induce some flowering.

Temperatures through the next seven days will be seasonable. Most highs will vary in the upper 20s through the 30s Celsius followed by lows mostly in the range of 12 to 19 degrees with a few readings over 20 in the north.
