Brazil, Caribbean Coffee Weather - Flowering May Begin In Brazil; Hurricane To Damage Cuba

Kansas City, October 3 (World Weather, Inc.) – Showers and thunderstorms are expected to evolve in many Brazil coffee production areas this week and sufficient rainfall will occur to induce some flowering. In the meantime, Hurricane Matthew will produce torrential rainfall and very strong wind over coffee production areas in eastern Cuba Tuesday possibly damaging a few trees and knocking some maturing coffee beans to the ground.

BRAZIL
Scattered showers and thunderstorms occurred in Brazil during the Friday through Sunday period. Rainfall in northern Sul de Minas, eastern Cerrado Mineiro, Zona de Mata, Espirito Santo and southeastern Bahia varied from 1 to 15 millimeters with a few coastal areas reporting up to 34 millimeters. One location along the central Bahia coast reported 74 millimeters of rain. Most of the precipitation in key coffee areas was too brief and light to induce flowering. Highest temperatures Friday through Sunday were in the upper 20s and 30s throughout coffee country except in a few areas from southern Zona de Mata and Rio de Janeiro to the port city of Sao Paulo where lower 20s were noted. Lowest morning temperatures were in the teens and lower 20s except in northern Sao Paulo where readings were as cool as 11. Rain will develop in Sao Paulo, southern Sul de Minas and Rio de Janeiro later today and tonight while isolated showers continue in eastern Bahia, the remainder of Minas Gerais and Espirito Santo throughout the day today. The most significant rain event this week is expected from northeastern Sao Paulo through Sul de Minas to Zona de Mata and Rio de Janeiro and Cerrado Mineiro Tuesday through Thursday of this week with rainfall varying from 13 to 35 millimeters and local totals of 35 to 65 millimeters. The rain will be sufficient for flowering, especially in Rio de Janeiro, Sul de Minas, Zona de Mata, Espirito Santo and northeastern Sao Paulo. The precipitation will shift to the northeast Thursday into the weekend with most of the precipitation concentrating on Bahia. Rainfall of 15 to 45 millimeters will result with a few greater amounts. Flowering is expected in many areas from northeastern Sao Paulo to Bahia over the coming week. Next week will be a bit drier with less significant and less frequent precipitation expected. Many areas will experience some net drying conditions next week, although daily showers will produce 1 to 8 millimeters and a few totals to 10 millimeters. The precipitation will erratically distributed with many areas staying dry or experiencing a net loss in soil moisture during the period. Areas from Sul de Minas and Zona de Mata into Parana may be wettest.

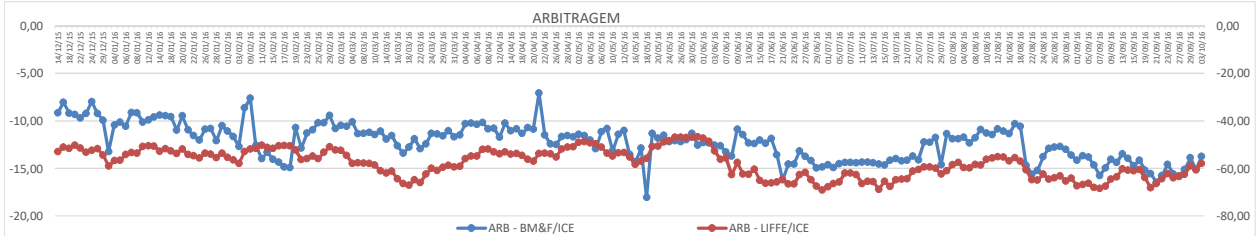
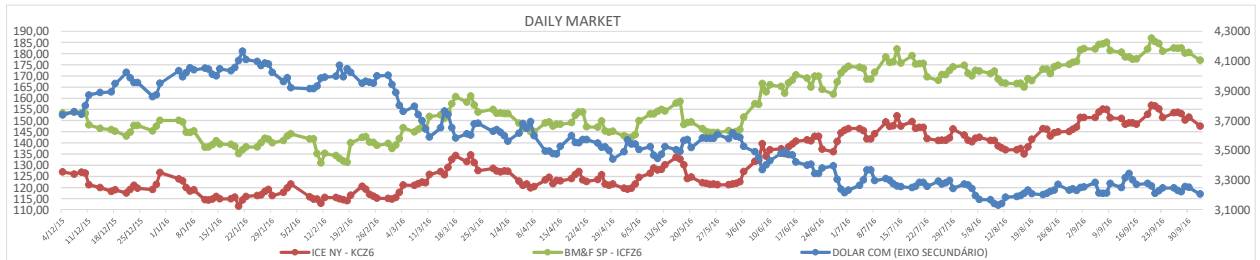
Temperatures will remain warm to hot in northern Minas Gerais and Bahia for the next couple of days with highs in the 30s and lows in the upper teens and lower 20s. Temperatures in northern coffee areas will trend cooler later this week and stay in a seasonable range of upper 20s and lower 30s through the weekend and into early next week. Similar temperatures will occur from Parana to Sul de Minas, Rio de Janeiro and Zona de Mata all week this week with highs in the upper 20s and lower 30s. Low temperatures at night are expected to cool to the upper single digits and teens from Parana into Sul de Minas and Zona de Mata.
