Brazil Coffee Weather Some Showers Likely This Weekend, Next Week

By Drew Lerner Kansas City, May 11 (World Weather, Inc.) – Another mostly dry day occurred in Brazil coffee production areas Wednesday and similar conditions were expected to continue into Saturday. Showers will develop this weekend is Sao Paulo and Parana before shifting northward into Sui de Minas, Espirito Santo and Zona de Mata next week. All of the rain is expected to be light, although some computer forecast model guidance today has increased inflatil in parts of Brazil's key coffee areas for mid- to late-week next week. World Weather, Inc. believes the increase in rainfall is overdone and future model runs will correct this exaggeration.

BRAZIL

BRAZIL Dry weather occurred again in most of Brazi's coffee production areas Wednesday and similar conditions were expected through Friday. High temperatures were in the 20s and lower 30s Celsius with western and northern Minas Gerais, Bahia and Zona de Mata warmest. The port oity of Sao Paulo reported the coolest afternoon temperature of 21 due to showers and thunderstorms that produced up to 15 millimeters of rain. A cool front moving through coffee areas from south to north this weekend will introduce the first opportunity for significant rainfall. The precipitation will begin in Parana and southwestern Sao Paulo Saturday and move to Sul de Minas and northeastern Sao Paulo Sunday. Rainfall will range from 1 to 10 millimeters with local totals to 15 millimeters. The precipitation will continue to shift further north early next week while rain intensity becomes a little lighter. However, rain chances for Bahia have been greatly diminished today relative to that suggested by some computer forecast model guidance Wednesday.

Some of the rain that moves north through Brazil early next week will retreat back to the south during the second half of next week. Daily rainfall of 1 to 15 millimeters will continue with Minas Gerais, Espirito Santo, Zona de Mata and Sui de Minas wettest. Temperatures will be seasonable during much of the coming week with highs in the middle 20s through the lower 30s. A few extreme highs will reach into the middle 30s in the far north. There is potential for some thermoon temperatures in the lower 20s during the weekend in Parana, Sao Paulo and southerm Minas Gerais behind the expected cool front. Low temperatures will be in the teens and lower 20s throughout the next full week.
