Coffee Market Report

The latest Commitment of Traders report from the New York Arabica coffee market has seen the Non-Commercial Speculative sector of this market increase their net short sold position within the market by 3.4% over the week of trade leading up to Tuesday 4th. September; to register a new net short sold position of 105,336 tots. This net short-sold position which is the equivalent of 29,862,289 bags has most likely been marginally decreased again, following the period of mixed but overall more positive trade, which has since followed.

Last week was yet another week devoid of striking fundamental news for the coffee market, with continued complacency on the part of the industries and while the week ended off, with the leading producer Brazil taking their independence Daylong weekend holiday. The Brazilians returning to the field of play today, to encounter a marginally firmer Real to the dollar exchange rate, which would be seen to be a factor that shall suppresses internal market selfing angressing.

This factor might prove to be market supportive for the markets on their opening, as would the evidence of an increase in the net short sold position of the speculative non-commercial sector of the New York market, which is hovering close to the recent record highs. Albeit that the steadily rising certified stocks of the New York market, does contribute towards negative sentiment.

The November 2018 to December 2018 contracts arbitrage between the London and New York markets broadened on Friday, to register this at 34.82 usc/Lb., while this equates to 33.99% price discount for the London Robusta c

The Certified washed Arabica coffee stocks held against the New York exchange were seen to increase by 8,193 bags on Friday, to register these stocks at 2,250,153 bags. There were meanwhile a larger in number 31,220 bags increase in the number of bags pending grading for this exchange; to register these pending grading stocks at 203,020 bags.
