Coffee Market Report

The latest Commitment of Traders report from the New York Arabica coffee market has seen the Non-Commercial Speculative sector of this market decrease their net short sold position within the market by 11.23% over the week of trade leading up to Tuesday 9th. October; to register a new net short sold position of 86,266 Lots. This net short-sold position which is the equivalent of 24,456,029 bags has most likely been reduced further, following the sharp positive correction for the market at the end of last week.

The latest Commitment of Traders report from the London Robusta coffee market has seen the Speculative Managed Money sector of this market decrease their net short sold position within this market by 39.55% during the week of trade leading up to Tuesday 9th. October, to register a net short sold position of 19,007 Lots on the day.

This net short sold position which is the equivalent of 3,167,833 bags has most likely been reduced further, following the period of more positive trade, which has since followed.

softer coffee market prices.


