## COFFEE

General Comments: Futures were lower in New York but held above the recent lows at the close. London was lower. Funds were the best sellers in both markets. New York trends are down, but the market once again is trying to form a bottom at current levels as it has held the recent range for a week or more. Weekly chart trends are sideways in London, but trends in daily charts are turning down. Prices are moving below profitable levels for Colombia, and have been below profitable levels for producers in Central America. Further weakness will cause farmers in Brazil, Peru, and Vietnam to start losing money as well. Brazil had a big production year for the current crop, but the next crop should be less as it is the off year for production. Vietnam is active in its harvest, but producers are not willing to sell at current prices. Production in Vietnam is estimated less than 30 million bags due to uneven weather during the growing season. The next production could also be less as drought is reported in the

central growing areas of the country. There are no forecasts for rains in current outlooks.

Overnight News: Certified stocks are higher today and are about 2.488 million bags. The ICO composite price is now 97.25 ct/lb. Brazil will get scattered showers or dry conditions. Temperatures should be above normal.

Colombia should get isolated showers. Central America and southern Mexico should get showers. Vietnam will get mostly dry weather. ICE said that 0 delivery notices were posted against March contracts and that total deliveries for the month now total 179 contracts.

Chart Trends: Trends in New York are mixed to down with no objectives. Support is at 97.00, 94.00, and 91.00 May, and resistance is at 103.00, 105.00 and 108.00 May. Trends in London are mixed to down with objectives of 1500 and 1470 May. Support is at 1500, 1480, and 1450 May, and resistance is at 1540, 1550, and 1560 May. Source: Jack Scoville
