COFFEE

General Comments: Futures were higher for the week in both markets as forecasts for cold air were made for southern Coffee areas of Brazil. It is not likely that the air would produce much in the way of damage, but it is an important reminder of what time of year it is in Brazil and the potential for damage due to cold and freezing temperatures. Weakness in the Brazilian Real caused some speculative selling earlier in the week in New York, while reports of steady offers from Asia hurt Robusta in London. The trade is still worried about big supplies, especially from Brazil and low demand. Brazil had dominated the market, and other exporters are having a lot of trouble finding buyers. However, buyers are now more actively pursuing other origins, especially for certified or higher end coffees. Roasters were scale down buyers on the extended down move and now have more than ample supplies in house or on the way. Prices are generally below to well below the cost of production for world producers and prices are getting to that point for producers in Brazil and Vietnam. The inventory data from ICO and others shows ample supplies in the world market. Brazil had a big production year for the current crop, but the next crop should be less as it is the off year for production. Ideas are that the next crop might still be big as the weather has been good for the trees so far. Mostly dry conditions are in the forecast for this week. The charts show that both markets could trade in a sideways to up pattern for now as the market looks at weather and production potential of the next crop.

Overnight News: ICE certified stocks are lower today at 2,407 million bags. ICE said that 0 notices were posted against May contracts and that total deliveries for the month are now 2,171 contracts. The ICO daily average price is now 94.09 ct/lb. Brazil will get mostly dry conditions, but some light showers today, with near to above normal temperatures. Vietnam will see mostly dry conditions.
