Coffee Market Report

The latest Commitment of Traders report from the New York arabica coffee market has seen the Non-Commercial Speculative sector of this market decrease their net short sold position within this market by 11.43%; over the week of trade leading up to Tuesday 2518th. June; to register a new net short sold position of 35,576 Lots. This net shortsold position which is the equivalent of 10,085,638 bags has most likely been decreased again, following the period of mixed but overall more positive trade that has since followed.

The leading robusta coffee producer in West Africa, Ivory Coast, has issued a provisional report that the countries

coffee exports for the month of May registered a 38% decline on that of the same month last year, to reach a total 98,133 bags. Cumulative coffee exports for the first five months of the calendar year are reported at an overall increase and a total 489,883 bags, or 16% higher than that of the same time last year.

The September to September contracts arbitrage between the London and New York markets widened on Friday, to register this at 43.63 usc/Lb., while this equates to 39.86% price discount for the London Robusta coffee market. The Certified washed Arabica coffee stocks held against the New York exchange were seen to decrease by 8,724 bags on Friday, to register these stocks at 2,370,625 bags.
