## Coffee Market Report

The latest Commitment of Traders report from the New York arabica market has seen the Non-Commercial Speculative sector of this market decrease their net short sold position within this market by 8.30% over the week of trade leading up to Tuesday 29th. October, to register a new short sold position of 50,777 Lots. This net shortsold position which is the equivalent of 14,395,054 bags has most likely been little changed, following the period of mixed but overall softer trade that has since followed.
